### Study Available

Siber Systems’ survey report, entitled “Password Management Survey: IT Managers Respond to the Impact of Password Policies on Security and Productivity,” reflects the input from 617 IT professionals from all levels and disciplines. It found that U.S. workers, managers, and IT staffs alike are increasingly confronted with difficulties arising from computer passwords.

The study detailed the distressing state of password protection in the modern enterprise. Over half of all respondents said the average employee in their firms are required to remember three to five passwords, with an additional 26% saying the number ranges from six to ten or more. Nearly half said that employees are required to use passwords more than 25 times per week; 66% stated that employees write down or store passwords in unsafe places, creating a security problem for their companies.

According to survey findings, one-third of companies surveyed plan on implementing a new or improved password management solution before the end of calendar year 2008.
